


December 1 is World AIDS Day



Globally, an estimated **36.9 million** people were living with HIV in 2014.

Pulmonary manifestations of AIDS may include:

- tuberculosis
- Pneumocystis jiroveci pneumonia
- bacterial pneumonia
- pulmonary Kaposi sarcoma



TB is the leading killer of people living with HIV.

About 1 in 3 deaths among people with HIV is due to TB.



The goal of UNAIDS: to end the AIDS epidemic by 2030.
